- Constitution Amendment Proposal
  - A. Attendance
    1. All voting Council members shall attend every meeting unless an absence is excused by the Chair. Council members who have planned absences shall notify the Chair 24 hours in advance, using email.
      - i. Some examples of excused absences may include sicknesses, class/school activities, religious accommodations, inclement weather, and other instances on a case-by-case basis as discussed with the Chair via email.
      - ii. If less than 24 hours' notice is given, the Chair must determine if the absence is excused based on the Council member's ability to have notified previous to the 24-hour window.
    2. RA Liaisons shall discuss their rotation of attendance previous to meeting with the Chair.
    3. Student Government Representative shall attend the first meeting of the month and continue regular communication with Members and the Chair for important information.
    4. The secretary will keep a record of unexcused and excused absences, as reported by the Chair, in the minutes.
    5. Three unexcused absences per semester may result in removal from the Council.
    6. Being 15 minutes late to meetings, unless previously excused, will result in an unexcused absence, on a case-by-case basis. Communicate with the Chair using email or GroupMe.
